Anyone who ""looks like"" a non-citizen is at higher risk of detention or other harm. But there is no real "looks like" a non-citizen, because citizenship doesn't cause changes in human appearance; we know such laws discriminate against BIPoC, the unhoused, & other oppressed folks.


